# Unpad Through Time

Universitas Padjadjaran (Unpad) was founded on **September 11, 1957**, in response to the growing demand for accessible, high-quality higher education in West Java.

What began as a regional initiative has evolved into one of Indonesia's most prominent public universities—known for academic rigor, cultural depth, and social relevance.

Initially headquartered in the city of Bandung, Unpad established its main campus in Jatinangor in 1983. Set against the green hills of Sumedang, this campus has grown into a vibrant academic ecosystem spanning 16 faculties and 2 schools, supported by additional campuses in Bandung, Pangandaran, Jakarta, and Garut.

These sites reflect the university's deep commitment to regional engagement while serving as gateways to broader national and international collaboration.



Unpad's institutional autonomy was elevated in 2014 when it was designated a Legal Entity State University (PTNBH) by presidential regulation.

This milestone marked a transition in how the university governs itself—enabling greater flexibility, independence, and global competitiveness across academic, financial, and operational domains.

Since then, Unpad has steadily advanced its mission through research-driven innovation, inclusive education, and strategic partnerships that transcend borders.

Over the past decade, the university has undergone a profound transformation. It expanded its digital infrastructure to support hybrid and online learning, deepened its commitment to inclusive access—particularly for students from underserved backgrounds—and elevated its research agenda through interdisciplinary centers of excellence.

The university has also launched a bold sustainability vision through its Smart and Green Campus initiative, embedding environmental responsibility into all facets of university life.

Unpad's global engagement has grown in both depth and breadth. The university has forged international academic alliances across Asia, Australia, Europe, and North America, developing joint degree programs, collaborative research, and student mobility schemes.

As a result, it is increasingly recognized as one of Indonesia's globally connected universities while remaining grounded in the cultural richness of West Java.

In 2024, Unpad designed its Strategic Plan for 2025–2029, reaffirming its commitment to shaping future global leaders, strengthening social and international impact, and expanding its role as a knowledge epicenter in the fields of health, economy, energy, socio-culture, and agrotechnology.

The university's long-term vision toward 2045 aspires to position Unpad not just as a center of learning but as a transformative institution that empowers people, communities, and systems.

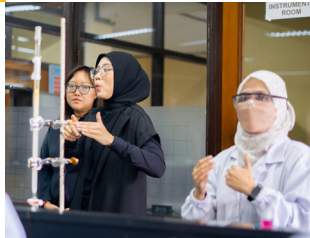

# Faculty of Economics and Business

The Economics and Business Faculty was established in accordance with Government Regulation no. 37 of September 18, 1957. The Faculty was initially a part of Universitas Merdeka under the Foundation of Universitas Merdeka Bandung, established in 1952, before becoming part of Universitas Padjadjaran five years later under the name Faculty of Economics. In 2011, the name of the Faculty was modified in order to make it a management and business school that can compete at an international standard, in line with Unpad's goal to be a world-class university.

# Faculty of Medicine

The idea to establish The Faculty of Medicine in Indonesia came first from the then Minister of Health, dr. Lie Kiat Teng, at the 1953 The Indonesian Medical Association (IDI) Congress in Surabaya. With the founding of Universitas Padjadjaran based on Government Regulation Number 37 of 1957, the Faculty of Medicine was established alongside three others, making up the first iteration of Universitas Padjadjaran.

Adhering to the development of knowledge and technology in medicine, a postgraduate education program was established in 1979. Then, in 2006, the Faculty opened a doctoral program for medicine

which was done in collaboration with Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia's Faculty of Medicine, proving its international recognition.

Currently, the Faculty of Medicine is focusing on efforts to develop its programs and facilities within the context of advancing internationalization, strengthening research and innovation, and improving the healthcare of the community, especially in West Java. The main goal for the Faculty is to break through into the top 500 ranking in the Life Sciences and Medicine category of the QS World University Rankings.

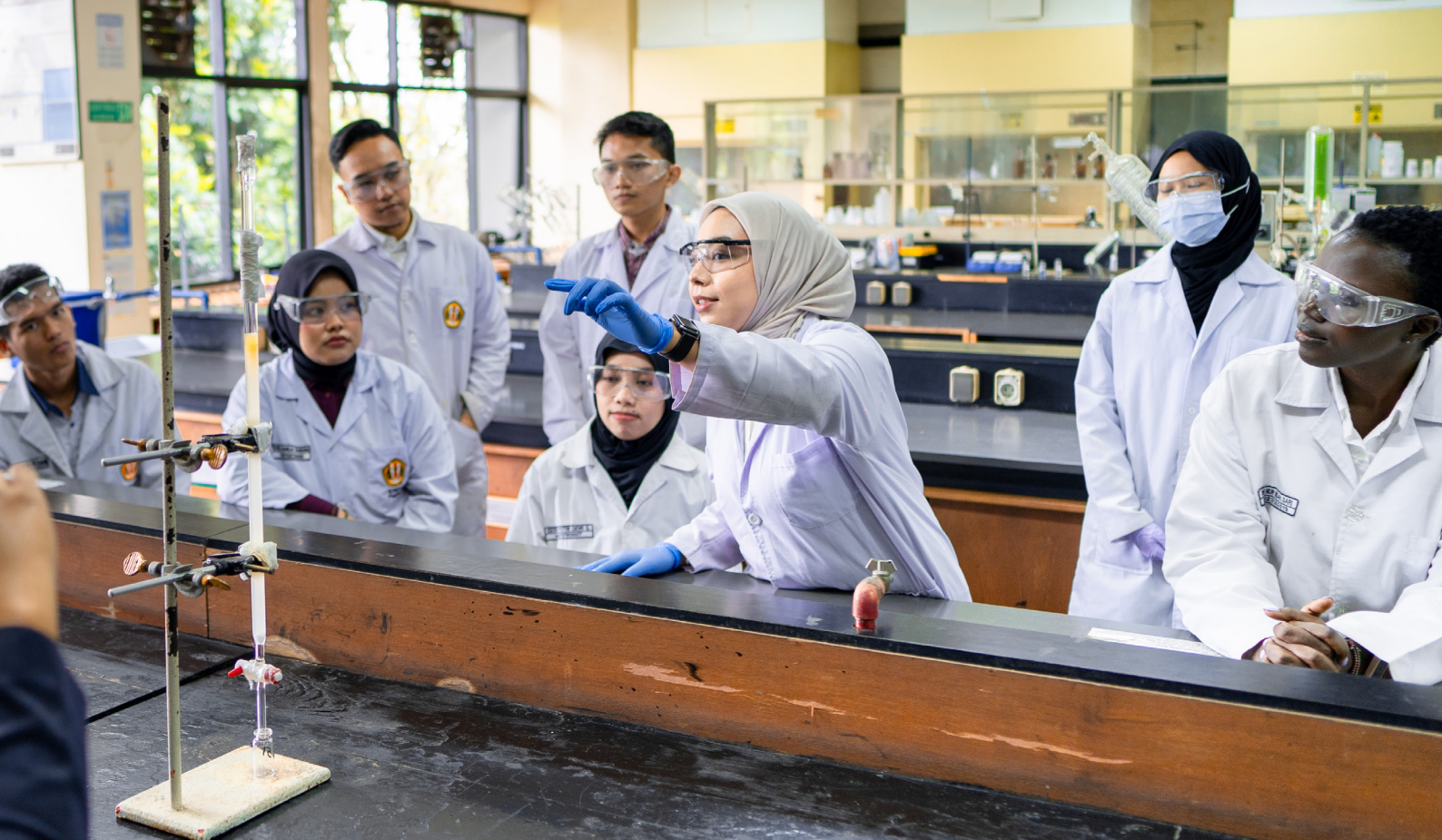

Inaugurated by the first president of the Republic of Indonesia, Ir. Soekarno, on 1958 accompanied by a speech titled "The Development of the Natural Sciences throughout the Centuries". The first iteration of the Faculty operated under the name Fakultas Ilmu Pasti dan Ilmu Alam (FIPIA) and included four disciplines, exact sciences (mathematics), physics, chemistry, and biology.

In 1982, the name of the Faculty changed into the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Science (FMIPA). Currently, FMIPA offers programs at both undergraduate and graduate levels, with 9 Bachelor's Degree programs, 5 Master's Degree programs, and 2 Doctoral programs.

This program includes the development of electronic learning materials, digital libraries, and interactive learning modules to support technology-based education that can be accessed by students and lecturers from various locations and platforms.



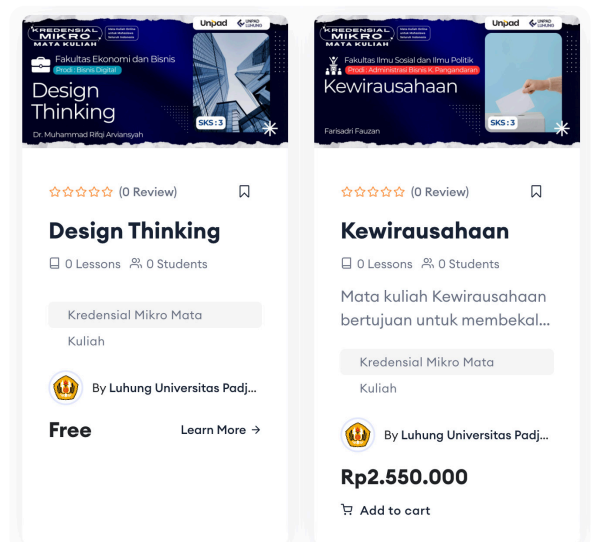

Our multidisciplinary team comprises experts in the field of clinical pharmacy, pharmacoeconomics, pharmacoepidemiology, drug utilization study, pharmacogenetics, pharmacology, molecular pharmacology, and nutraceuticals.

PHARCI has collaborated with various government institutions, industry, health care facilities, NGOs, educational institutions and research centers. These collaborations have created several products, innovations, scientific articles, and policy recommendations.

PHARCI has established several facilities that can support the research and collaboration, such as Medication and Therapy Adherence Clinics (MTAC), Animal Research and Innovation Center (ARIC), Center of Development for Biologic Therapy, Cell Biology and Molecular Laboratory, and Growth Hub (Business Incubator).

## Campus Life

To realize this vision, Universitas Padjadjaran has made efforts to maximize the use of various assets across its campuses, including the main campus at Dipati Ukur, Jatinangor, and Pangandaran campus. To produce outstanding graduates, Universitas Padjadjaran also strives to facilitate students in off-campus learning and extracurricular activities. Through participation in various non-academic activities outside the classroom, students

can improve their personal development and also acquire essential soft skills such as emotional intelligence, teamwork, self-management, leadership, creativity, critical thinking, and the ability to solve complex problems. Universitas Padjadjaran offers a variety of Student Activity Units related to creativity, interests, and talents, including music, sports, arts and culture, community development movements, and more.

Students from all academic levels can choose the activity units that interest them and engage in inclusive campus activities. The development of these Student Activity Units is not only aimed at developing creativity, interests, and talents but also at helping students achieve accomplishments both nationally and internationally.

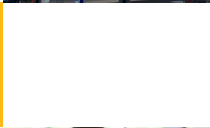

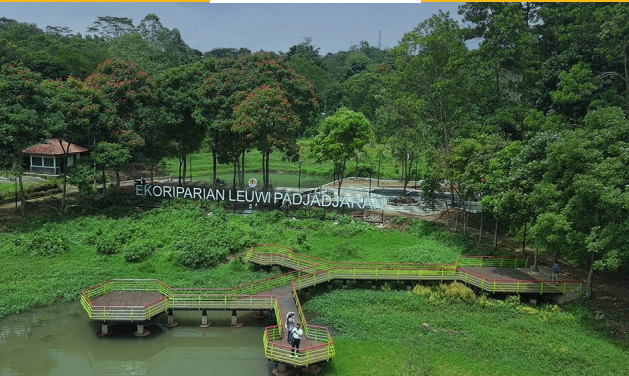

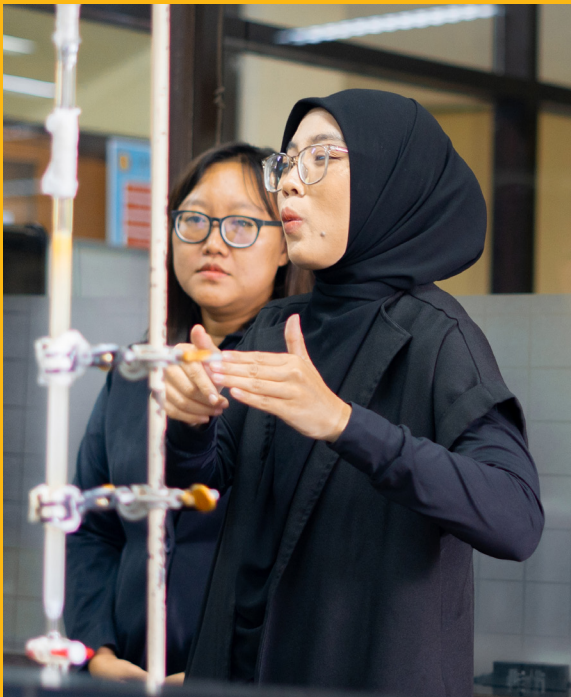
